Biography

As a founding member of the **Artis-Quartet Vienna**, Othmar Müller performes on the most important stages of the music world since 1980.

He appeared with the quartet in venues like Carnegie Hall New York, Teatro Colon Buenos Aires, Wigmore Hall London, Philharmonie Berlin, Suntory Hall Tokyo and of course in the quartets basis, the Musikverein Vienna, where they play their own series of concerts since 1988.

In recent years Othmar Müller started to perform as a soloist in recitals and with orchestra.

Besides recitals in Europe and the US, he gave **first performances** of works by Gottfried von Einem, Holmer Becker, Herwig Reiter (Celloconcerto at the Berlin Konzerthaus with the WJO under Herbert Böck in 2001) and presented the rediscovered sonata by Alexander Zemlinsky at the Musikverein in October 2006 to an enthousiastic audience.

His **recordings** of sonatas by Zemlinsky-pupils (Weigl, Webern & Müller-Hermann) will be released on the NIMBUS label December 2006, his recording of the Zemlinsky sonata on NAXOS late 2007.

Since 2005 he is the **conductor** of the Camerata of the Allegro-Vivo Summer Festival.

His **instrument** is a cello by Andrea Amati (1573), on loan by the Austrian National Bank.
